We developed many tactics (!!!) and really got into SWOS. We appreciated the ECE version which was even better. In the year 1996 I went to England for half a year in terms of student exchange. As I was on a shopping tour through Northampton I discovered a double-CD with SWOS ECE and the Upgrade for 96/97! I was thrilled. The price was ridiculous, 9 £!
