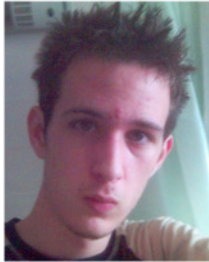




DOMINANT WIN FOR COOLIO JACK

In what had been billed as a close encounter, Turkish Champion Ottoman was trounced 7-2 by Coolio Jack in Champions League Final.



Coolio Jack celebrates his second Champions League title. He had won the competition last season for the first time. Ottoman after the match: "I had no chance to achieve a surprise success. The favourite player hold the cup..."

Coolio Jack kept his good performance, but he could just reached second place in the Super League. Lucaa has successfully finished the Super League as Champion.

Lucaa collected 38 points in 18 matches, while Coolio had 37 points in 18 matches and Lucaa got his first Super League "Gold Medal"...

Stromberg has played a great season in German League and achieved his second German Premiership. But in Super League, he has been relegated! Sasy will also play in 2nd League this season. Red82 achieved "happy end" in Czech League and it is his first success in his career. Ottoman has won his 8th Turkish Super League, which Coca Cola has won two times before.

Other national leagues winners are: Hellum (Den), Rijntje (Bnl) Foka (Pol), Coolio Jack(SCS), Giggs (Por), Infiltrate (UK)... German Cup Final: Fidelito - Schulle: 5-7...

Jiggaplaya has won the ISSF Cup after a 3-1 win over Marin Purashev (Bul), who had qualified via Outertoto and surprisingly reached the final. The Italian Serie A has not been played last season. The Portuguesse player had also no fun to play their league games as they played 4 games of 56...
