

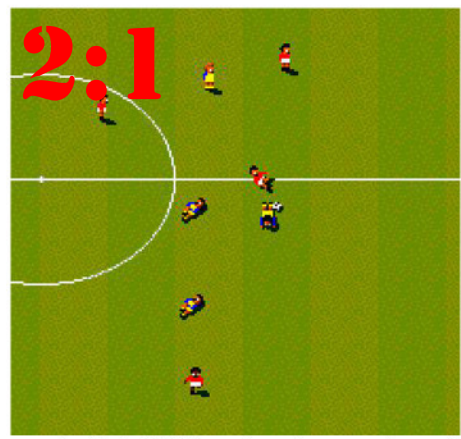

2 NEW LEAGUES FROM MAY ON!

The UK Premiere Division and BeNeLux 1 will be played in this season. ISSF has now 9 national leagues including Germany, Poland, Turkey, Croatia, Italy, Denmark and Portugal. If all national leagues are played at the end of the season, the Champions League and ISSF will look like that: 2 teams to Champions League and 1 team to ISSF from 1st-3rd ranked nations. 1 team to Champions League and 2 teams to ISSF Cup from 4th ranked nation and 1 to Champions League and 1 ISSF from the 5th-9th ranked nations. Last season 19 from 29 available matches in Champions League have been played. In ISSF Cup 21 matches from 45. However, more participations are expected this year.

Playaveli writes : SENSIBLE DAYS 2005

Pirmasens (Germany), 13.08.2005 – After the huge success of the Sensible Days 2004 we had a great anticipation for the year 2005 and its tournament . I arrived on Friday , coming to Pirmasens directly from my France trip. Redhair was already waiting at the rented location. He had put in some work to install some PCs and get some drinks. We welcomed ourselves and had a talk about SWOS and other nice things of life. In the early evening Metzger joined us and we started to play some rounds at the table football and also some friendlies of PC SWOS. But none of us wanted to show his full potential before the big Saturday.



In the late evening Oli O. and Obi-Wan from Northern Germany and Elmichaj from Berlin finally arrived in Pirmasens. It was about 11 p.m. as we had installed all PCs (Oli O. and Obi-Wan brought some equipment including a beamer!) and Amigas.

We continued to play some friendlies and had a couple of beers, talked and laughed a lot. The atmosphere

was really great and everybody was having a good time. Well, our good friend Obi-Wan was sitting in front of his PC and acted like a robot who tries to warm himself up ?!

It was a bit disappointing that some players couldn't make it to Pirmasens this year. For example the ISSA - Crew from Denmark and the Belgian Previous - year - winner Greg, just to name some.

Nevertheless on Saturday morning Nowar and KTS joined us from Stuttgart and the "Eifel - Crew " (Craizinho and Zokrates) also found their way to Pirmasens. Insane from Holland completed the field of participants; he was reliable just like the year before.



At about 11 a.m. we started the PC SWOS tournament. We agreed to play a league with following play-offs. As it came to arrange the schedule everybody was somehow confused and the situation nearly got out of hand. Finally Obi-Wan and me simulated a league in SWOS with custom teams (named after the players) and simulated the whole schedule and wrote it down on a paper. A little disaster in the age of league managing programs ? ! So now it was time for kick-off; the rocket was launched.



From the beginning Craizinho was the biggest surprise to all of us veterans. He came from nowhere and was an incredible player . He showed no respect on the pitch and fought really hard. Redhair was the best defender (which was not a surprise to me) and conceded the fewest goals. Accordingly he was a hot prospect for the title.

Furthermore Elmichaj was performing world class against Obi-Wan and Playaveli (4-2 and 3-0) and proved to be a giant killer. On the other side of the table the newbies KTS and Nowar were shown their limits. Nevertheless they had a lot of fun and were fair opponents and nice dudes. Some unusual happenings were my defeats against only the same players (4 defeats, all to Elmichaj and Oli O.) as well as Micha's tactic which I don't want to mention here anymore ? ! Altogether Oli O. played a fantastic tournament in the league stage and reached the first place.

In the early afternoon everybody was a more or less hungry and we decided to make a break. Metzger and his Dad had cooked Chili stew. And it was so much and so sharp that many of us were nearly killed by it ? ! The tiredness was giving us the rest. But after a hour of break the tournament went on with the play-offs.



First of all I have to mention that the drawings of the quarter final went wrong (caused by a wrong table). Redhair should have played against Elmichaj and myself against Craizinho. But I ended up in a clash with Redhair and Elmichaj had to fight against Craizinho. The other quarter finals were: Obi-Wan/Insane and Oli O./Zokrates!

Obi-Wan and Oli O. showed their strenghts and pulled through to the semis as it was expected from them. The other to clashes were really great matches. Elmichaj once again performed world class and ended Craizinho's glorious way to the title. Besides this Playaveli really showed against Redhair why he is called a killer and pounced on his few chances to eliminate Redhair.

In the semi final it was time for a real thriller: Obi-Wan/Playaveli. Elmichaj played against Oli O. in the second semi final.

In the first leg Oli O.'s ambition on the title was ended by a fantastic performing Elmichaj, loosing 2-5. Micha did it again. Playaveli seemed to be knocked out by veteran Obi-Wan who won the first leg 2-0.

In the second leg Micha was just playing for the result and concentrated himself on his defense to stop Oli's attackers.

The semi final second leg between Playa and Obi-Wan was the definite highlight of the whole Sensible Days. Very soon after kick-off Playa scored for the 1-0 and performed very well in the continuing match. About in the middle of half 2 Playa scored another goal to draw the aggregat. In the 90th minute Obi-Wan missed a late winner to pull through to the final by wasting his best chance of the whole match. Extra-Time had to be played and both Obi and Playa were really nervous and just tried not to make any mistakes. So what now? Right: PENALTY SHOOTOUT!

In the meantime all the other players sat behind Playa and Obi and watched the spectacle. It was really interesting because Playaveli as well as Obi-Wan both choose Barcelona as their team so none of them had any advantage. After the fifth penalty Obi-Wan spoke out what I felt: "I am totally exhausted!" All players scored their penalty. Playaveli's right-back was the last field player to shoot his penalty and he succeeded. Obi-Wan's counterpart missed.



The final draw was Elmichaj / Playaveli. The matches were not so exciting like the semis. Playa won the first leg (3-0, 2 mistakes by Micha's goalie and one dream goal) and was only focussing on his defense in leg 2! Micha wasn't able to score more than 1 goal. Playaveli won the final 3-1 on aggregate.

He was awarded with an Amiga 600 and nice cup. 2nd and 3rd placed players were awarded with silver and bronze medal.

All other participants were rewarded with sport clothes from LEGEA24.
