I moved back to SWOS when it was released on PC with the 95/96 edition, although it was fast but the later 96/97 version was and is perfect. After some years I started creating my own tactics and thats the reason why I stayed. No other game is so exciting, funny and "creative" (because of tactics) likeSWOS.
